Description

print ([string \\$str](#))

Parameter

[\\$str](#): The data to print

Return Values

None

Example

```
<pre><?
  print("Hello\r\n");
  print("World\r\n");
?></pre>
```

The above example will output:

```
Hello
World
```

Note

This function does not add new line characters (CR/LF) to the output but if that is needed you can easily append them with `\r\n` or `\n`
