**array array\_keys ( array \$array )**

Return an **array** object

## Parameter

**\$array**: An **array** with key/value pairs

## Return Values

An **array** of keys

## Example

```
<pre><?
$arr=array();
$arr['name']="John";
$arr['age']=30;
$arr['status']=1;
$keys=array_keys($arr);
print_r($keys);
?></pre>
```

The above example will output:

```
[$keys] = Array (
(string) [0] => name
(string) [1] => age
(string) [2] => status
)
```
