JSON encode an **array** into a **string**, with optional method

## Description

**string** json\_encode ( **array** \$array [, **int** \$method ] )

Return a **string** containing the JSON<sup>1)</sup> encoded representation of an **array**

## Parameters

**\$array**: An **array** to parse

**\$method**: Optional, output the JSON code **string** to represent an *object* or an *array*:

- **0** - object (default for **\$method** not specified)
- **1** - array (without keys)

## Return Values

JSON encoded **string**

## Example

```

    $arr=array();
    $arr['a']=1;
    $arr['b']=2;
    $arr['c']=3;
    print(json_encode($arr)."\r\n"); // encode as an object (default method)
    print(json_encode($arr,0)."\r\n"); // encode as an object
    print(json_encode($arr,1)."\r\n"); // encode as an array
?></pre>
```

The above example will output:

```
"$arr":{"a":1,"b":2,"c":3}
"$arr":{"a":1,"b":2,"c":3}
"$arr":[1,2,3]
```
