

# print

WMPRO, WMMINI FW >= 1.0 WMMEGA FW >= 2.0

Print **data** to the current output stream such as a web page or terminal

## Description

```
print ( string $data )
```

## Parameter

**\$data**: The data to print

## Return Values

None

## Example

```
<pre><?
  print("Hello\r\n");
  print("World\r\n");
?></pre>
```

The above example will output:

```
Hello
World
```

## Note

This function does not add new line characters (CR/LF) to the output but if that is needed you can easily append them with `\r\n` or `\n`
