URL-encode a string

## Description

**string** urlencode ( **string** \$data )

This function is convenient when encoding a string to be used in a query part of a URL, as a convenient way to pass variables to the next page.

## Parameter

**\$data**: **String** to be encoded

## Return Values

**String** with certain characters encoded. Returns a string in which all non-alphanumeric characters except - \_ . have been replaced with a percent (%) sign followed by two hex digits and spaces encoded as plus (+) signs. It is encoded the same way that the posted data from a WWW form is encoded, that is the same way as in application/x-www-form-urlencoded media type.

## Examples

```
<?
  $data="#G(2BH) "
  $send=urlencode($data);
  print($send); //  %23G%282BH%29
?>
```
